



## Winterizing Procedure

To protect your water pipes from freezing and/or bursting, you must complete the following during the winter months when outside temperatures drop below 32° for two or more consecutive days.

- Turn of water supply to exterior faucets. (The cut off valves are located either at your water heater, under kitchen or bath cabinets, or in your basement.)
- Turn exterior faucets on to insure drainage of water from the cut off locations. Remove hoses. **LEAVE IN OPEN POSITION.**
- **Do not, under any circumstances, turn your heat off during the winter.** Preferably, never set the thermostat below 55°.
- During abnormally cold weather, you should also leave interior faucets dripping at night. You may also wish to open bottom cabinets to allow warm air to circulate around the pipes.

**Your warranty does not cover frozen/bursting pipes, as it is your responsibility to winterize your home for protection.**
